

REVOCATION OF PUBLIC DEDICATION AND  
ABANDONMENT OF ALLEYS

PARISH OF JACKSON

BEFORE the undersigned Notary Public and undersigned legal and competent witnesses, personally came and appeared:

DELTON SPILLERS, the duly elected Mayor of the Town of Chatham, Jackson Parish, Louisiana, appearing herein pursuant to Ordinance No. 2000-2 of the governing body of Chatham, Louisiana, dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2000.

The Town of Chatham, by this act, does hereby formally revoke the public dedication of and does forever abandon from public use the following alleys within Block 9 of the Town of Chatham, Louisiana and full ownership rights unencumbered by any public dedications, servitudes, or right of ways of the land comprising said alleys is hereby transferred, delivered and vested in the adjacent landowners, namely Sue Scruggs Brown, and Richard A. Gibson and Helen Gibson, their heirs and assigns forever, to-wit:

An alleyway 20 feet in width extending along the entire east boundary of Block 9 of the Town of Chatham as per plat of survey on file in the records of Jackson Parish, LA, said alleyway extending from Maple Street to Summers Avenue.

Also:

An alleyway 20 feet in width which bisects Block 9 of the Town of Chatham, said alleyway extending from Maple Street to the east boundary of Block 9 and separating Lot 6 of Block 9 from Lots 2,3,4 and 5 of Block 9, as per plat of survey of file in the records of Jackson Parish, LA.

Both alleyways being situated in the Town of Chatham, in the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4, Section 3, T15N, R1W, Jackson Parish, LA.
