**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF CHATHAM TO DECLARE AS ABANDONED CERTAIN ALLEYS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF CHATHAM, LOUISIANA AND TO REVOKE DEDICATION TO PUBLIC USE.**

Be It Ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Chatham, Louisiana, at a regular meeting duly called and held, that:

**Section 1**

An alleyway 20 feet in width extending along the entire east boundary of Block 9 of the Town of Chatham as per plat of survey on file in the records of Jackson Parish, LA, said alleyway extending from Maple Street to Summers Avenue.

ALSO

An alleyway 20 feet in width bisects Block 9 of the Town of Chatham, said alleyway extending from Maple Street to the east boundary of Block 9 and separating Lot 6 of Block 9 from Lots 2, 3, 4, and 5 of Block 9, as per plat of survey on file in the records of Jackson Parish, LA.

Both alleyways being situated in the Town of Chatham, in the SE1/4 of SE1/4, Sec. 3, T15N, R1W, Jackson Parish, LA.

**Section 2**

Neither alley has been maintained by the Town of Chatham, nor used by the public since the establishment of said alleys. It will not adversely affect the public welfare of the Town of Chatham, nor its citizens to revoke the dedication of said alleys for public use and to abandon said alleys as they no longer serve a public purpose. (A description of said alleys is attached hereto as Exhibit A)

**Section 3**

The Mayor of the Town of Chatham is hereby authorized to sign a formal revocation of the dedication of said alleys for public use and to abandon said alleys to the current landowners of the property adjacent to said alleys, free of any public dedications, servitudes or right of ways, all as is authorized by L.R.S. 48:701.

**Section 4**

This ordinance shall become effective on the date of its publication in the official journal.

The above and foregoing ordinance having been offered by Marvin Davis and duly seconded by Frances Womack, said ordinance having been read section by section, was then submitted to an official vote as a whole and adopted by the following vote:
