ORDINANCE NO. 12-129

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF CHATHAM TO DECLARE AS ABANDONED CERTAIN ALLEYS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF CHATHAM, LOUISIANA AND TO REVOKE DEDICATION TO PUBLIC USE.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Chatham, Louisiana, at a regular meeting duly called and held, that:

Section 1

An alleyway 20 feet in width extending along the boundary of Block 12, Block 4 and 5 of the Town of Chatham as per plat of survey on file in the records of Jackson Parish Courthouse, Jonesboro, Louisiana, said alleyway extending from Louisiana 4 going south 142 feet.

Section 2

This alley has not been maintained by the Town of Chatham, nor has it been used by the public since the establishment of said alley. It will not adversely affect the public welfare of the Town of Chatham, nor its citizens to revoke the dedication of said alley for public use and to abandon said alley as it no longer serves a public purpose.

Section 3

The Mayor of the Town of Chatham is hereby authorized to sign a formal revocation of the dedication of said alley for public use and to abandon said alley to the current landowners of the property adjacent to said alley, free of any public dedications, servitudes or rights of ways, all as is authorized by L.R.S. 48:701.

Section 4

This ordinance shall become effective on the day of its publication in the official journal.
