ORDINANCE 2021 – 01

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE SEWERAGE RATES FOR OUTSIDE OF THE TOWN OF CHATHAM, LOUISIANA’S CORPORATE LIMITS AND OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS it is necessary to set and adopt sewage rates to allow the Town of Chatham to carry out the maintenance and operation of the sewage system outside of the corporate limits of Chatham, Louisiana.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Chatham, Parish of Jackson, State of Louisiana, that rates and fees are adopted for sewer users supplied by the Town of Chatham located outside its corporate limits:

SECTION 1: The following rates shall apply:

A. Outside – Residential

	Minimum charge for up to 1000 gallons	All over 1000 gallons or part thereof
Single Family	\$28.60	\$5.50 per 1000 gallons
Mobile Homes	\$28.60	\$5.50 per 1000 gallons
Mobile Home Parks	\$28.60 (x no. of mobile homes)	\$5.50 per 1000 gallons (x no. of mobile homes)

B. Outside – Commercial

\$50.00 Minimum charge for up to 1000 gallons
\$6.50 All over 1000 gallons or part thereof

SECTION 2: The deposit rate for outside residential sewer is set at: Owner: \$100.00 Renter: \$150.00; The deposit rate for outside commercial sewer is set at \$200.00.


SECTION 3. The council will review these rates at the beginning of each fiscal year and may increase rates by one to ten (1% - 10%) percent as determined through the budgetary process.


This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
